

Door metrics sensors by Notus

Now you can increase your fishing productivity as Notus are supplying a 3 in 1 sensor that can monitor door angle, trawl wire length and door spread. The most critical angle is the heel angle of the door. This part of the sensor answers many of the questions skippers have about doors such as: are the doors rigged correctly, do I have the right amount of wire out, and has the door fallen over? Pitch angle information can also be provided.

Notus have also built their well known trawl wire measurement into the

Door Metrics Sensor which measures the distance of the vessel to the trawl door. The DMS also offers door spread capabilities when a slave is installed on the clump or opposite door.

Door spread is a critical piece of information to ensure the trawl door is operating correctly. It has a large impact on fuel consumption when fishing in heavy currents as the optimal spread can be maintained on the gear.
